Between camp drop-offs and vacations, our Temple Emanuel community came together this summer to accomplish some wonderful social action projects. Volunteers took care of our gardens, keeping the plants vibrant not just for us, but also for our pollinators. Volunteers visited two local organizations to prepare meals for those they serve: The Women's Center and Shelter of Greater Pittsburgh and Veteran's Place. Volunteers beautified spaces in Temple Emanuel by lending a hand to paint throughout the building. Our Team Sandwich volunteers donated roughly 1,000 sandwiches, some of which went to Carnegie Elementary School for their summer food distributions. Finally, the Temple Emanuel community donated 23 pounds of food, including fresh vegetables and herbs from our garden, and numerous school supplies to SHIM.
