Together with rabbis from around the country, he will learn with NGOs across the spectrum of Israeli advocacy efforts, volunteer in various capacities around the country, and talk to citizens, soldiers, and politicians: all to better understand — and bring back to our community — the realities of life in contemporary Israel.
