Environmental sustainability through a low-waste lifestyle is something that I've always felt was important but difficult to achieve, as there aren't many options for low-waste products at the stores where I typically shop. However, a new business in Mt. Lebanon offers an easy shopping experience for those looking to use less waste and shop locally: The Wonderfill Low Waste Refillery Market.

At Wonderfill, you can bring your own soap containers to fill and buy locally made products. You can also recycle unique items like yarn for a yarn rescue project that will allow local knitters to create hats and scarves for those in need, and ReCork which recycles your natural wine corks to create carbonnegative materials.
