

Deadly By Design

RAC-PA and CeaseFire PA are working together to encourage lawmakers in our state to pass bipartisan, common-sense gun laws. Temple Emanuel congregants have written letters to representatives and engaged in other advocacy work for these bipartisan laws, led by Ron Richards. Cantor Kalix is joining the effort and has organized a screening of <u>Deadly By Design</u>, a project of CeaseFire PA's Education Fund to shed a light on gun violence in our state.

They invite you to join them to hear from Pennsylvanians about the losses they've suffered under a system that is "Deadly by Design," discuss our own stake in this work as Jews, and take action together- because we know the best way to save the next life is to change that system.
