Yizkor Meditations

At the same time, the implication is that this act of remembrance also constitutes a guarantee of Jewish continuity--well beyond just those we remember, and far beyond us as well. In remembering and in asking for God's remembrance, we request divine help in continuing our people's trajectory beyond ourselves, to achieve the ultimate aims of our people's history.

Yizkor is, in the end, not a prayer for the dead, but a promise by the living.
