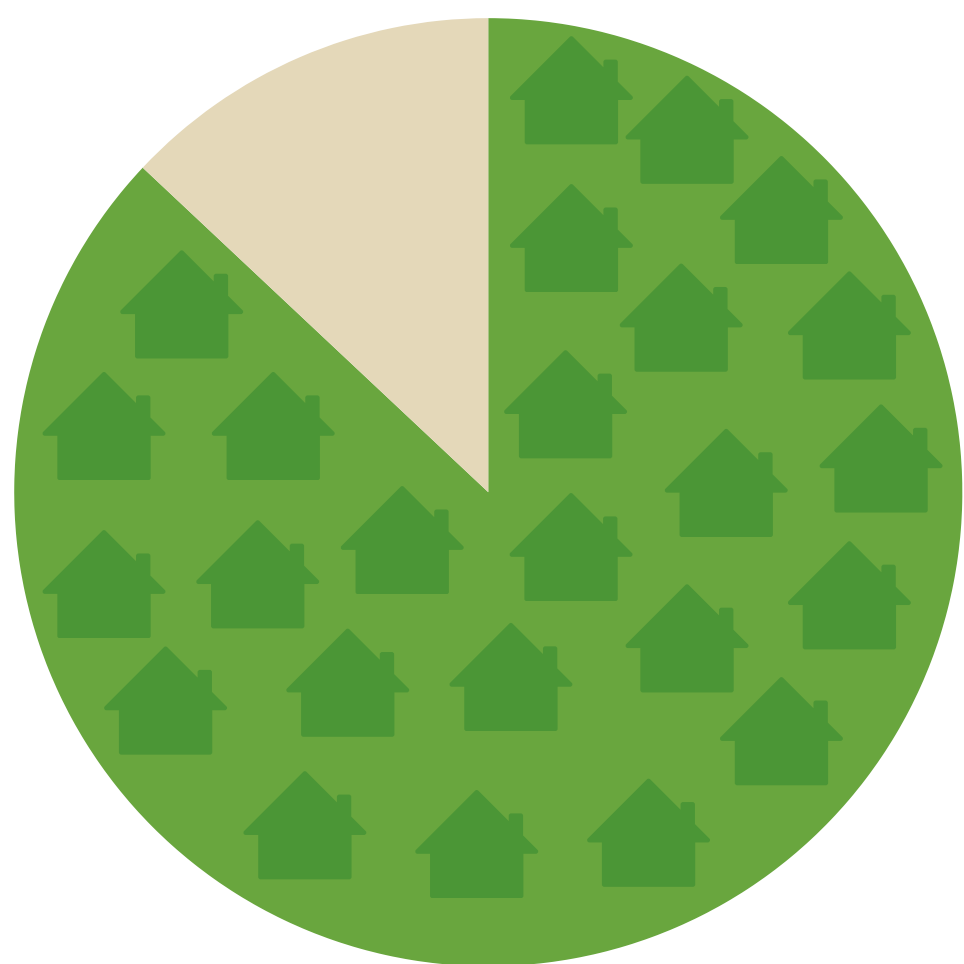

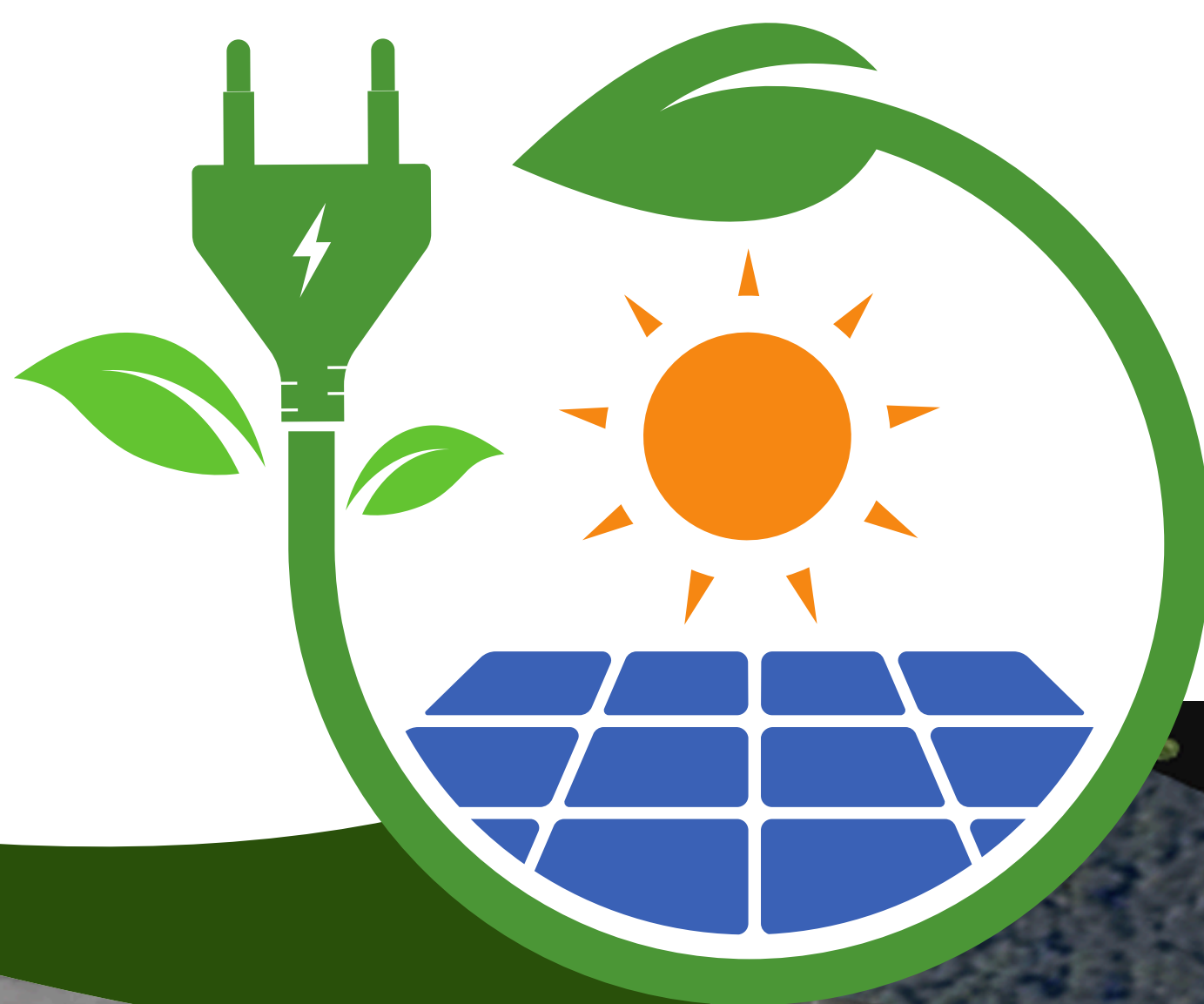


## Generate 87% of Temple's Electricity

Temple's solar panels will generate 249,356 kWh per year, offsetting 87% of Temple's annual electricity needs and bill: the equivalent of 25 average family homes!

## Save Temple \$1.4 Million Over 30 Years

The panels have an 85% production guarantee through 30 years, meaning we expect these panels to generate 1.4 million dollars for Temple in this time span.



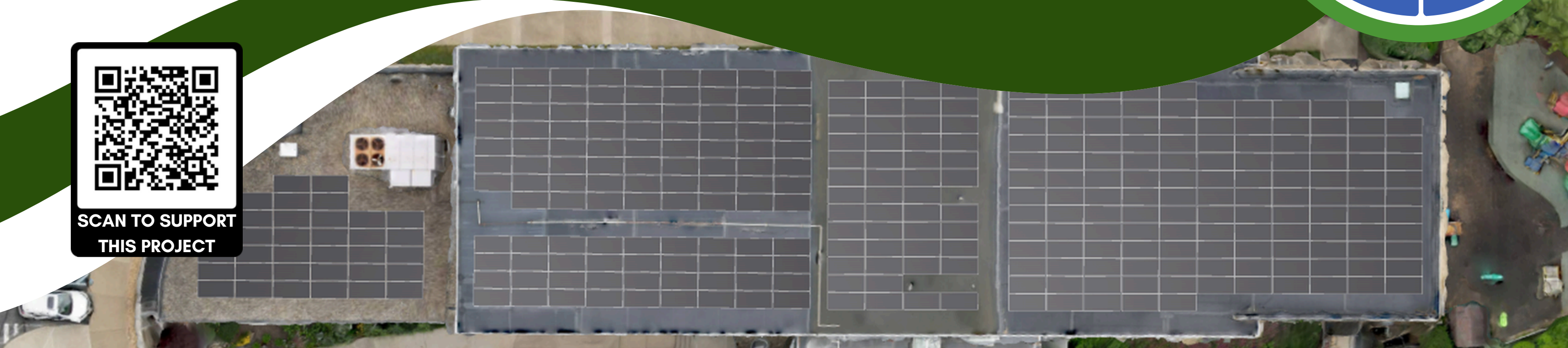
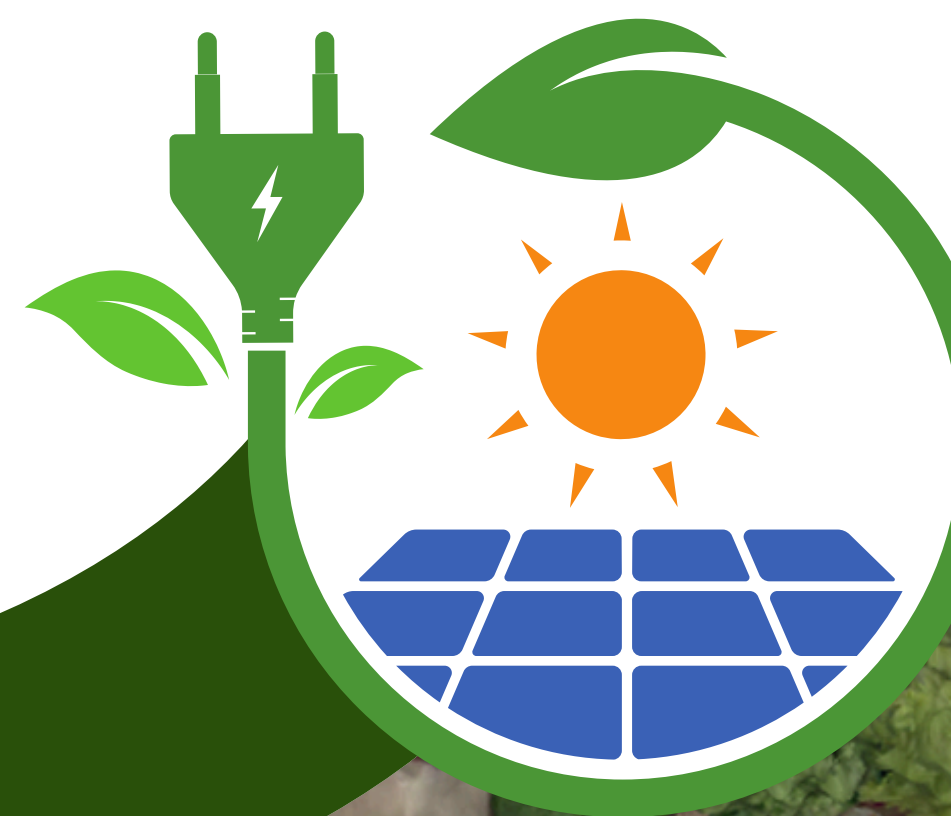

Bal Tashchit is the mitzvah of not destroying nature; even a fruit tree in war time should be protected. In Sefer HaMitzvot, Maimonides says: "And not only trees, but whoever breaks vessels, tears clothing, wrecks that which has been built up, or wastes food in a destructive manner transgresses the commandment of Bal Tashchit."

To mend, repair, and transform our world through acts of justice is a uniquely human endeavor and our responsibility as a Jewish community. In the 1999 Pittsburgh Platform, Reform Judaism affirmed: "We bring Torah into the world when we strive to fulfill the highest ethical mandates in our relationships with others and with all of God's creation."
